



## Cost of Living

The cost of living in Edmonton may be different than the cost of living in your home country. Here are some approximate monthly costs for a single student with modest spending habits.

Estimated living expenses	Monthly cost in CAD\$
<b>Housing</b>   MacEwan residence	<b>\$988</b>   bachelor apartment <b>\$822</b>   four-bedroom apartment <b>\$775</b>   two-bedroom apartment <b>\$525</b>   shared double studio suite
<b>Housing</b>   Homestay	<b>\$1000</b>   including 3 meals a day and private bathroom
<b>Housing</b>   Apartment rental	<b>\$1300</b>   one-bedroom apartment <b>\$1500/2 = \$750</b>   two-bedroom apartment
Food	<b>\$300</b>
Local transportation	U-pass (bus pass which is included in student fees, September to April)
<b>Utilities</b>   Electricity	<b>\$70</b>
<b>Utilities</b>   Telephone (mobile)	<b>\$60</b>
<b>Utilities</b>   Telephone (home phone)	<b>\$30</b>
<b>Utilities</b>   Cable tv/internet	<b>\$30</b> (tv) plus <b>\$35</b> (internet) = <b>\$65</b>
Personal expenses/recreation	<b>\$200 - \$300</b> (depending on your budget)
Childcare expenses	<b>\$700 - \$1000</b>
