## Requirement

6 credits of ENGL 102 and 3 credits in university ENGL (not including ENGL 111, 108, or 211)
6 credits in a single language other than English (same language) or 6 credits in world literature
(COMP 102 and COMP 103)
6 credits of Humanities (CLAS, HIST, HUMN, or PHIL)
6 credits of Sciences (ASTR, BICM, BIOL, BOTN, CHEM, CMPT, EASC, GENE, PHYS, PSYC, SCIE, or ZOOL)
6 credits of Social Sciences (ANTH, ECON, GEND, POLS, PSYC, SOCI)
3 credits of Analytical Studies (LING 101, MATH, PHIL 125, or STAT) not including MATH 099
3 credits of Fine Arts (AGAD, ARTE, CRWR, DESN, DRMA, MUSC, THAR, THPR, CLAS 252, 352, 353 or 356)
Fine arts courses taken to fulfill this breadth requirement will not count toward a student's 15 credit out of Faculty limit.
$\square$ Minimum 120 credits of non-duplicative coursework
$\square$ Minimum 300-and 400-level requirements for the major (refer to the specific applicable major planning sheets)
$\square$ Minimum 300- and 400-level requirements for the minor (refer to the specific applicable minor planning sheets)
$\square$ Maximum of 15 credits for independent work (project, field placement, and/or individual study courses) excluding th Honours thesis. Note: specific disciplines may have further restrictions
$\square$ Minimum of 60 credits completed at MacEwan University
$\square$ Maximum of 60 credits in any one discipline
$\square$ Maximum of 48 credits at the junior level (100-level)
$\square$ Minimum of 72 credits in Arts courses
$\square$ Overall Graduation Grade Point Average (GGPA) of 2.0 or higher
$\square$ Minimum GPA of 2.0 on all courses credited towards the majors
$\square$ Minimum GPA of 2.0 on all courses credited towards the minors
$\square$ Maximum of 3CR of PACT coursework

## IMPORTANT PLANNING NOTES

1. Students are bound by the year in which they declare their major(s) and/or minors(s)
2. The same course cannot be used to fulfill more than one requirement for a major(s) and/or minor(s). Additional course work may be required to fulfill the credit requirements of the major(s) and/or minor(s)
3. Courses with the notations of W (withdrawal), AU (Audit), or TR (transfer) are not included in any GPA calculation
4. WRIT 101 can be used in place of ENGL 102 to fulfill the junior-level English requirement
5. MATH 099 is not a degree-level course and cannot be used to fulfill BA degree requirements
