| 1. Junior-level English requirements, combined with the 6CR in one language other than English (LOE), can be used to fulfill the 12CR Language and Literacy breadth requirements of the Bachelor of Arts degree. <br> 2. Equivalent courses may be used to meet this requirement, including previously offered ENGL 100 (6CR), 101 (6CR) and 105 (6CR). <br> 3. Students who have previously taken ENGL 267 will be permitted to use that course to fulfill their Literary Theory requirement. Alternately, ENGL 267 may be used as a prerequisite for the new Literary Theory courses. The prerequisite for each of ENGL 391, 392, 393, and 394 is one of ENGL 267, 282, 283, 284, 285 or 286.
