IMPORTANT PLANNING NOTES

- 1. The six credits students choose to fulfill their junior level prerequisite requirements a Bachelor of Science or Bachelor of Arts degree's core requirements.
- 2. Students who are interested in senior level weather and climate studies should take **EASC 102**. Students who wish to pursue geology or planetary studies should take **EASC 103**.
- 3. Arts students who choose an Earth and Planetary Sciences minor must comply with Bachelor of Science minor residency requirements. Science minors must complete a minimum of nine senior level MacEwan credits, including a minimum of three credits at the 300- or 400-level.
- 4. Students may take both **EASC 495** and **EASC 498** for credit a maximum of two times, as long as the course topic is different each time they take the course.
