Declaration Process	
The Finance minor is a competitive minor. Students must complete FNCE 301 prior to the close of declarations.  There are 10 seats available in the Finance minor each year. Students will submit their declaration by January 15. Students who apply will be ranked by their admissions GPA, which is calculated by using their most recent 24 credits of university-level course work, without breaking up a term. Applicants with the 10 highest GPAs will be admitted to the program. Students will be notified of the success or denial of their application to the Finance minor no later than February 1.
